



Job Posting - Coalition Organizer

New Economy Project works with community groups to build a just economy that works for all, based on racial and economic justice, equity, and ecological sustainability. We seek an experienced coalition organizer to join our team.

The position offers an excellent opportunity to work directly with grassroots and constituent-led organizations on campaigns for economic democracy and transformational change. Organize policy campaigns that support community-led, cooperatively-structured workplaces, housing, energy systems, land trusts, financial institutions, and more.

You will play a leadership role in organizing a multi-year public banking campaign for NYC. New Economy Project has recently launched a city-wide public banking campaign, along with a cross section of community, labor, civil rights, and environmental and climate justice groups. The campaign seeks to ensure democratic control over public funds (i.e., the people's money); investment in community-based, new economy initiatives; and divestment from Wall Street banks, which routinely harm NYC neighborhoods, fuel climate change and private prisons, and engage in many other destructive practices.

CORE RESPONSIBILITIES

You will play a leadership role in coalition organizing, with focus on a city-wide public banking campaign. Your responsibilities will include:

- Engaging in strategic outreach and membership recruitment, and deepening relationships among coalition member organizations.
- Working with a broad cross-section of community, labor, civil rights, and climate justice groups to lay groundwork for creation of a public bank for NYC, including pressing NYC to divest from Wall Street banks.
- Planning and facilitating meetings, conference calls, and other coalition activities.
- Collaborating with coalition members to develop policy advocacy and communications strategies.
- Coordinating presentations for community-based organizations and other constituencies, to publicize the campaign and engage new members.

EXPERIENCE AND QUALIFICATIONS

- At least 3 years' experience working on progressive community, labor, electoral, or other campaigns.
- A track record of successful coalition work.
- A demonstrated commitment to social, economic, and racial justice.
- Excellent interpersonal and communication skills, and an ability to develop strong relationships with a wide array of people and groups.
- Outstanding writing and communication skills; excellent attention to detail.
- Familiarity with New York City and State political landscapes preferred.
- Fluency in Spanish a plus.
