New Economy Project (formerly NEDAP) seeks law interns for **Summer 2017**. New Economy Project works with grassroots groups to promote economic justice and to build a new economy that works for all, based on principles of cooperation, democracy, equity, racial justice, and ecological sustainability. We provide education, training and legal support to community groups and their members, and lead coalitions and campaigns to expand economic opportunity in low-income and immigrant neighborhoods and communities of color.

New Economy Project law interns work on a range of projects, and gain experience in direct legal services, policy advocacy, and coalition organizing. Summer 2017 law interns may, for example:

- Work on impact litigation;
- Support community groups in NYC working to establish community land trusts, worker cooperatives, and community-based credit unions and loan funds;
- Staff a legal hotline for low-income New Yorkers aggrieved by discriminatory and abusive financial practices;
- Conduct research in support of corporate accountability and shareholder advocacy initiatives; and
- Participate in policy campaigns, including to secure strong federal rules against payday lending and debt collection abuses.
